MESSAGE FROM HON. CHAIRMAN



The most successful companies, organizations and groups have one thing in common – the ability to ignore individual differences and work as a 'team'. Individual Weaknesses Are Covered Up

Everyone makes mistakes. But these must be seen an lessons. Other team members perform their best to cover up the loss. In the end, the total result matters, not the individual achievements.

• Individual Strengths Become 'Total' Strength

Each person has his own strengths. Now, these individual strengths collectively become more powerful. Remember the concept of synergy? One plus one is greater than two. One always performs better as a team rather than as individuals.

You Think along with Others

Each person has a different understanding of the same situation. Take the opinion of the team members with the help of a little brainstorming. Thus, one thinks about a solution with the help of another person's mind.

As Stephen Covey says, "Strength lies in differences, not in similarities." Thus, one thinks of a solution to a problem with the help of another person's mind. Therefore, it is important for a leader to appoint the right managers, listen to their opinions and proceed with a certain strategic plan. Theodore Roosevelt, the 26th president of the United States was once asked about teamwork, "The best executive is the one who has sense enough to pick good men to do what he wants done, and self-restraint enough to keep from meddling with them while they do it," he said. This also takes a lot of pressure off, and unwanted expectations from, the leader.









Online Session on Art Integration

An online session on art integration for middle-aged students was held on 18th November 2024, from 3:30 PM to 5:00 PM.











Developing Sustainable Self Study Habit (A must read article for all students)

Most of the parents are always worried about their wards' studies in general and their marks/result in particular. Teachers also try to make studies easy and students put in their best efforts to secure good grades. Yet, time and again, there are instances of dissatisfaction, disappointment and dismay.

As it is rightly said by the wise that one may take a horse to waters but it can't be made to drink. In the present context, this means that though the parents and teachers can turn every stone to ensure that the students get the best learning environment and the facilities, the ultimate responsibility of studying is on the students' shoulders. Students alone have to plan their studies and follow the plan in a determined manner. The parents and the teachers can only support and facilitate the students in every possible way.

With the hope that this article finds the students who are passionate about studies but don't have the right plan and strategy to make their dreams a reality, here are a few points which all the stakkeholders may consider.

Firstly one needs to evaluate himself/herself for his/her own strengths and weaknesses. Everyone must agree that out of all the subjects to be studied, we are good at some, not so good at others and poor at the rest. A conscious self evaluation shall help us to decide our next step in the journey of education.

Having done the self evaluation, one can easily understand as to with which subjects he/she is comfortable and those he/she needs to focus more on. This is the right time when one can start his/her self studies. Just begin with the subject which is the most difficult for you. Practice it everyday regularly. Simultaneously keep studying the other subjects as well.

Number of study hours is the most important factor which determines the magnitude of a student's success. The general rule is that the number of study hours for a student should be equal to the grade in which he/she studies. It means that a student of garde 5 should study for 5 hours everyday and so on. One has to increase the study time upto 8 hours and maintain it thereafter. Of course, it requires determination and persistance.

Many a times, students mistake homework for self study. No. They both are different. Homework is the assignment which helps to inculcate the values like obideince, respect, sincerity etc. in students. But, self study alone can help any student to master different subjects and stand in a good stead. With the self study, first benefit that one gets is confidence and sense of fulfilment. As they say, practice makes man perfect, regular self study is a way to achieve perfection in studies. So, one must finish the homework quickly and start the self study! Place of study also has a great importance. A student must fix his/her study place in the house. Keep all the required study material within the reach of the hand. Everyday, start the first self study session with a silent prayer to invoke the blessings of the Goddess Saraswati and Lord Ganesh as they are the repositories of all knowledge. After every 30 minutes, take a small break to relax the mind. During a break, drink a few sips of water, sit comfortably and just close eyes for a few minutes. This helps to calm and soothe mind. But be mindful not to go online or play any game or indulge in any distractive activity. In around 5 to 7 minutes the next session must start.

Noting down the doubts and queries and approaching teachers for their resolution is a key skill which every student must develop. It is a very simple task yet equally important in one's academic growth and development.

Meditation plays a vital role in maintaining our physical and mental well being. Everyday, one needs to do physical exercise and meditation for about 15 to 20 minutes. This is enough. Also, it is equally important to take rest when tired. It is needless to emphasize on the importance of a balanced diet and sound sleep. Recall early to wake and early to rise makes man healthy wealthy and wise.

Dear students, I know it is quite demanding, but see what best you can do. But remember that those who fail to plan, plan to fail.


Art Integration
